COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 256, L.D. 325, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Solicitation sales of Consumer Merchandise."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§4662" by striking out in the 6th line (5th in L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation "visit, a telephone call or by mail" and inserting in its place the following:

'visit or a telephone call'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§4663" by striking out in the 6th line (5th in L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation "visit, a telephone call or by mail" and inserting in its place the following

'visit or a telephone call'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§4663" in the 8th line (7th in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "sale" the following

' ,the consumer may void the contract or sale'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the applicability of the law to solicitations by mail and provides for avoidance of the contract or sale by the consumer which was omitted from the original bill.
