COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 262, L.D. 330, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Revocation of Certain Inland Fisheries
and Wildlife Licenses."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of paragraph I and
inserting in its place the following:

'I. Revocation by commissioner. The commissioner may revoke,
without refund, any resident license, if the licensee fails
to furnish proof of residence within 14 days of written request.
Such request shall be made to the address shown on the license.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the time for
furnishing proof of residence to 14 days, and to specify that
written requests for proof of residence are to be sent to the
address given on the license.
