**AN ACT Concerning Revocation of Certain Inland Fisheries and Wildlife
Licenses.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2401-B, sub-§ 16, ¶ I is enacted to read:

I. Revocation by commissioner. The commissioner may revoke, without refund, any resident license, if the licensee fails to furnish proof of residency within 30 days of written request.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow the revocation of licenses of persons who have purchased resident licenses and are not entitled to same.
