STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Further Defining the Attorney General's Authority Under the Unfair Trade Practices Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 5 MRSA § 208, sub-§ 1, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 577, § 1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 1. Regulatory boards. Transactions or actions expressly authorized under laws as administered by any regulatory board or officer acting under statutory authority of the State or of the United States; or

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clearly authorizes the Attorney General to regulate or enjoin unfair trade practices so long as a state or federal board, acting within its jurisdiction, has not expressly approved of the questioned trade practice.
