Amend the Amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 4. 10 MRSA §1107, 3rd sentence, is amended to read:

All investigations or hearings thereunder or connected therewith

to which witnesses are summoned or called upon to testify or to

produce books, records or correspondence shall be public or private

at the choice of the person summoned and shall be held in the

county wherein the act to be investigated is alleged to have been

committed, or if the investigation is on petition it shall be

held in the county where the petitioners reside.'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a person summoned under this section with a choice of a public or private hearing.
