COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 291, L.D. 348, RESOLVE,  
to Appropriate Moneys for Research on Black Fly Biology and  
Continued Research on an Environmentally Safe Insecticidal  
Control for Black Flies.

Amend the Bill in the 8th indented paragraph in the last  
line by inserting before the period the following: ', except  
that none of the funds appropriated shall be used for the ap-  
plication of insecticides to streams, rivers, lakes, ponds or  
other waters in the State'

Statement of Fact

This amendment prohibits the using of research funds  
appropriated for application of insecticides to any waters in  
the State. The funds may be used for any other department  
research concerning the black fly.
