SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 295, L.D. 352, Bill, "AN ACT Granting Implied Powers to the Public Utilities Commission."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§313." by striking out all of the 2nd sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'The commission shall have all implied and inherent powers pursuant to chapters 1 to 17 which are necessary and proper to faithfully execute its express powers and functions specified in chapters 1 to 17.'

Further amend the bill in the 6th line before the statement of fact by inserting after the underlined word "technical" the underlined words 'and immaterial'

Statement of Fact


The 2nd full sentence proposed by this amendment substitutes language more capable of legal interpretation than that in the original bill while accomplishing the same objectives of the bill.
