STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Make the Term of Office of the Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages Coterminous With That of the Governor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA \S 57, 1st \P , as enacted by PL 1975, c. 741, \S 4, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

The Commissioner of Finance and Administration, with the advice and consent of the State Liquor Commission, shall appoint a Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages whose term of office shall be coterminous with that of the Governor. The salary of the director shall be fixed by the Governor.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to change the term of office of the Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages to make it more congruous with similar positions in other departments.
