SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 281, L.D. 375, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Payment of Workmen's Compensation Pending an Appeal to the Supreme Judicial Court."

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§104-A." in subsection 1 by inserting at the end before the punctuation the following:

' , except that the commission shall retain jurisdiction, pending the decision on appeal, to enter orders or decisions as provided in section 100'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that the commission retains jurisdiction to make necessary adjustments in the payment of compensation pending an appeal.
