HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 137,
L.D. 378, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for the Practice of Architecture
through a Corporation or a Partnership."

Amend the Amendment by striking out in the 3rd paragraph
the next to the last sentence and inserting in its place the
following:

'One-third of the directors or partners shall be licensed under the
laws of any state to practice engineering, architecture, landscape
architecture or planning.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the 1/3 members of the board not
required to be architects may include architects. This will
enable architectural firms to comply with the requirement that
this 1/3 represent related professionals but does not exclude
architects from this group. Some firms may have difficulty
complying with the committee amendment.
