COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "/\ " to S.P. 146, L.D. 387, Bill, "AN ACT
Converting Rangeley Plantation into the Town of Haley."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 6th line
(5th line in L.D.) the figure "1977" and inserting in its
place the figure '1978'

Further amend the Bill by inserting after section 2 the
following:

'Sec. 3. Legislative district. Until the next legislative
apportionment of Representatives, the Town of Haley shall remain
in the same legislative district in which Rangeley Plantation
is now classed.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the headnote
and the first sentence of section 3 and inserting in their place
the following:

'Sec. 4. Referendum; effective date; certificate to Secretary of
State. This Act shall be submitted to the legal voters within the
territory embraced within the limits of said proposed Town of
Haley, voting by ballot at an election to be specially called
and held for the purpose within 12 months of the date of enactment
of this Act.'

Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out in the
1 line of the 2nd paragraph (4th line in L.D.) the figure
'1977" and inserting in its place the figure '1978'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delay the date of incorporation of this town until 1978, to specify the legislative district and to remove the emergency preamble and clause, as unnecessary.
