HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 343, L.D. 388,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Maine Turnpike Authority."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 6th
paragraph from the end, before the statement of fact, and in-
serting in its place the following:

'4. Reconstruction of access roads. Reconstruction of inter-
connecting access roads where such reconstruction will improve
vehicular access to the turnpike.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the
4th → paragraph from the end, before the statement of fact,
and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Construction or reconstruction of interchanges or re-
construction of access roads. No funds for construction or re-
construction of interchanges or reconstruction of interconnecting
access roads as provided by section 335, subsections 3 and 4 shall
be expended until the department proposals for such construction
or reconstruction have been included in the capital budget and
have been reviewed by the Legislature. In the case of new con-
struction of access roads, legislative approval in addition to
review shall be required.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit any new construction of access roads along the turnpike without specific legislative approval.
