STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Prohibit the Use of Electronic Devices for the Purpose of Detecting Radar.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 1254, 1st ¶, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 731, § 50, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

The use of any electronic device for the purpose of detecting radar being utilized by any law enforcement officer for the purpose of speed detection is prohibited.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the use of radar detectors to determine where law enforcement efforts are being conducted for speed control purposes.
