COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 149, L.D. 391, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Representation of State Employees under
the State Employees Labor Relations Act."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'26 MRSA §979-C, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Negotiation of union security. Nothing in this
chapter shall be interpreted to prohibit the negotiation of
union security, excepting closed shop.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the
negotiability of union security clauses in collective bargaining
under the State Employees Labor Relations Act. The proposed
language is the same as it appears in the statute governing
collective bargaining of university employees.
