IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Remove Restrictions on the Salary of County Commissioners who Hire Full-time County Administrators.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 202, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 736, § 3, is repealed as follows:

Notwithstanding section 2 and any other provision of law, if the county commissioners hire a full time county administrator, they shall forego the annual salary otherwise due them and shall only receive \$25 each for each meeting attended and reimbursement for travel at the same rate established for state employees

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove restrictions on the salary of county commissioners who hire full-time county administrators.
