**AN ACT to Remove Restrictions on the Salary of County Commissioners
who Hire Full-time County Administrators.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 202, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 736, § 3, is repealed as follows:

~~Notwithstanding section 2 and any other provision of law, if the county commissioners hire a full-time county administrator, they shall forego the annual salary otherwise due them and shall only receive \$25 each for each meeting attended and reimbursement for travel at the same rate established for state employees~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove restrictions on the salary of county commissioners who hire full-time county administrators.
