## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 316, L.D. 407, Bill, "AN ACT to Extend the Time During which School Budgets may be Adopted."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§3754." by inserting at the end the following underlined sentence:

'If a municipal charter provides that a budget proposed by a municipal official or body becomes effective when the municipal legislative body fails to adopt a budget by a specified date or within a specified period of time and that date falls prior to May 1st, that date shall be governed by the provisions of this section for the calendar year 1977.'

## Statement of Fact

Some municipal charters state that unless the council formally adopts a budget by a specified date or within so many days of a specified date, the manager's budget becomes the approved municipal budget. This amendment would preclude that effect until the municipal legislative body has sufficient information concerning state appropriations in order to properly adopt a budget.
