COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to H.P. 318, L.D. 409, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Notification of Results of Election Contests by the
Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the last 2 underlined
sentences before the statement of fact and inserting in their
place the following:

'Those findings of fact and opinion shall be mailed to the parties
by certified mail within 3 days after the commission adopts those
findings of fact and opinion.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to insure, without imposing
undue restrictions on the Commission on Governmental Ethics and
Election Practices, that all parties in election contests before
the commission receive a copy of the commissioner's findings of fact
and opinion.
