AN ACT to Appropriate Funds to Purchase Copies of "Franklin Sesquicentennial 1825 to 1975" by Bruce Carter, and "History of Franklin" by Henry Oberman for Sterling Douglas, Deceased.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Library; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$800 for the fiscal year 1977-78 to be used to purchase 100 copies of "Franklin Sesquicentennial 1825 to 1975" by Bruce Carter, and 100 copies of "History of Franklin" by Henry Oberman for Sterling Douglas, deceased. The breakdown shall be as follows:
