AN ACT Appropriating Funds for the Purchase of Copies of "Archaeological Excavations at Pemaquid, Maine, 1965-1974," by Helen Camp.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Library; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$695 for the fiscal year 1977-78 to be used to purchase 100 copies of "Archaeological Excavations at Pemaquid, Maine, 1965-1974," by Helen Camp.
