AN ACT to Provide for the Purchase of Copies of "The History of the Town of Cumberland" Edited by Phyllis Sweetser.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Library; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year 1977-78 to be used to purchase 100 copies of "The History of the Town of Cumberland" edited by Phyllis Sweetser.
