COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 336, L.D. 427, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal Fishing Regulations on the Pemaguid River."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the lobster fishing season will be starting shortly in this area; and

Whereas, the limitation of fishing would be detrimental to the local fishing industry and should be immediately removed; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, Health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to put an emergency preamble and an emergency clause on the bill.
