STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Repeal the Oversize Lobster Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 4451, 1st and 2nd sentences are amended to read:

The commissioner shall provide a measure, designated as the state double gauge lobster measure, for determining the legal length of lobsters. The commissioner shall cause one the gauge on the measure to be 3 3/16 inches in length and the other 5 inches in length.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA \S 4451, sub- \S 2, as amended by PL 1969, c. 408. \S 5, is repealed.

Sec. 3. 12 MRSA § 4455, sub-§ 2 is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate the maximum length limits on lobsters and will permit the taking of all lobsters over 3 3/16 inches in length.
