RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds to the Maine Mothers Committee to Offset Expenses incurred by the Maine Mother-of-the-year in Representing Maine in Washington, D.C.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies : and

Whereas, the Maine Mother-of-the-year must journey to Washington, D.C. in the spring to represent Maine; and

Whereas, funds traditionally authorized by the Governor and Council are not available because of the abolishment of the Council, and therefore, a legislative appropriation is required; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Maine Mothers Committee; funds for. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be appropriated from the Governor's Promote Maine Fund to be paid to the Maine Mothers Committee to offset expenses of representing Maine on April 5, 1977, in Washington, D.C.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
