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**AN ACT Prohibiting the Unlicensed Practice of Funeral Services.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 1506 is enacted to read:

§ 1506. **Licensed practice.**

No person, partnership, corporation, association or other organization shall open, operate or maintain a place for the practice of funeral services or hold themselves out as practicing the profession of funeral services unless the person, partnership, corporation, association or organization has been granted a license under this chapter by the State Board of Funeral Service.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit a person from practicing funeral services unless a license is issued to him by the State Board of Funeral Services under Title 32, chapter 21.
