STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Appropriate Funds for Repair, Operation and Maintenance of Androscoggin Lake Dam.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture. Soil and Water Conservation Commission, the sum of \$5,000, for the purpose of repairing the Androscoggin Lake Dam, a state-owned dam in Leeds, Androscoggin County, Maine. The breakdown shall be as follows:

1977-78

AGRICULTURE, DEPARTMENT OF Soil and Water Conservation Commission All Other

\$5,000

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Androscoggin Lake Dam in Leeds, Androscoggin County, is a state-owned dam built in 1931 for the purpose of preventing water from the Androscoggin River from entering Androscoggin Lake. The floodgates were replaced in 1976; however, the concrete portions are spalling, exposing portions of the reinforcing steel and one abutment is eroding. The floodgate debris screen also needs replacing. It is estimated that the work can be accomplished for \$5,000.
