STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase the Notice Fee for Renewal of Registration of Motor Vehicles by the Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 106-B, is enacted to read:

§ 106-B. Notification of expiration

The Secretary of State or his designee shall notify any holder of a motor vehicle registration, which is due to expire, of the date of that expiration, provided that the holder has paid to the Secretary of State a notification fee of 50¢ at the time at which the holder last paid the application or renewal fee for that registration. This notification shall be sent no more than 60 days nor less than 30 days before the expiration date of the holder's registration.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill ensures that the Secretary of State will notify persons, whose motor vehicle registrations are due to expire, of the fact of that expiration at least 30 days before the expiration is to take place.

It also provides that the cost of notification shall be voluntarily borne by a 50¢ application fee.
