STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Payment of Registration Fees for Motor Trucks
and Truck Tractors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA § 246, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 623, § 44-A, is further amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph the following:

With the concurrence of the Commissioner of Transportation, the Secretary of State is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the incremental payment of fees required under this section. In promulgating these rules and regulations, the Secretary of State shall consider the financial impact of the registration fee on the registrants, the benefit or burden of such installment paying on the state revenues and any difficulty which the Motor Vehicle Division may encounter in administering this section. This paragraph shall apply only to the registrations and associated fees for motor trucks and truck tractors.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective on February 1, 1978.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow the Secretary of State and the Commissioner of Transportation to establish an incremental payment schedule for the registration of motor trucks and truck tractors. The Motor Vehicle Division will realize no financial or administrative impact.
