COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 378, L.D. 467, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Employment Security Tax Liens."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'<u>26 MRSA §1227, sub-§2, last sentence</u>, as enacted by PL 1975, c, 462, §9, is amended to read: The fee to be paid by the commission for recording each such certificate is \$1 <u>\$3</u>, which need not be prepaid.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to raise the fee the State pays to file a lien for unpaid employer contributions to the unemployment compensation fund. This increase is to compensate for increased costs in the different registry of deeds' offices.
