HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 387, L.D. 477, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Rat Control on Public Dumps."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the first paragraph of that part designated "<u>§4103.</u>" and inserting in its place the following:

'Whenever a municipality shall maintain public dumping grounds, it shall be the duty of its municipal officers to see that such dumping grounds are treated at-least-once-a-year, when needed, with proper rat exterminating agents, such agents to be applied by competent persons properly trained-in certified for the use thereof.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes language requiring a license for rat extermination because a certification is all that is needed. It is not necessary to set up an additional license for rat extermination.
