COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 173, L.D. 490, Bill, "AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Maine Health Systems Agency, Incorporated, to Ensure That Quality Health Services Are Available at a Reasonable Cost to all Maine People."

Amend the bill in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) after the enacting clause by striking out the symbol and figure "\$100,000" and inserting in its place the symbol and figure '\$25,000'

Further amend the bill in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) after the enacting clause by striking out the symbol and figure "\$110,000" and inserting in its place the symbol and figure '\$25,000'

Statement of Fact

This amendment reduces the appropriation to \$25,000 each year.
