HOUSE AMENDMENT"A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to S.P. 179,
L.D. 493, Bill, "AN ACT to Assess a Surcharge on Fines and Penalties
for the Operation of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first 2 paragraphs and inserting in their place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out in that part designated "§2807." everything after the first paragraph and before the 4th paragraph from the end, and inserting in its place the following:

'In addition to every fine or forfeiture imposed for a criminal offense or traffic infraction, an additional amount equal to 10% of the amount of the fine shall be paid by the defendant to the clerk of the court.'

Statement of Fact

The additional charges imposed on a defendant under the original bill would have a varying impact on the defendant depending on the size of the fine imposed on the defendant. For example, the additional charge on a \$5 fine represents 40% of the amount of the fine, while the charge on a \$10,000 fine represents a fraction of 1% of the amount of the fine. This amendment establishes a straight 10% surcharge regardless of the size of the fine.
