AN ACT to Reduce the Fee for Lobster Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

¹² **MRSA § 4404, sub-§ 5, 1st sentence**, as amended by PL 1975, c. 565, § 20, is further amended to read:

The fee for a lobster and crab fishing license is ~~\$20~~ **\$15** which the applicant shall enclose with his application.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would reduce the cost of a lobster and crab fishing license from \$20 to \$15.
