SENATE AMENDMENT A " to S.P. 182, L.D. 496, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the State Librarian to Purchase Town Histories and other Maine Histories for Distribution to Public Libraries and Schools."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$7,000 for the fiscal years 1977-78 and 1978-79, to be used to purchase histories under this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
