SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
394, L.D. 498, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Administration of
Laws by the Bureau of Taxation."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the 10th paragraph
and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the last
paragraph of section 8 and inserting in its place the following:


Production does not include biological processes, wood
harvesting operations, the severance from sand, gravel, oil,
gas or other natural resources produced or severed from the soil
or water, or activities such as cooking or preparing drinks,
meals, food or food products by a retailer for retail sale.

The foregoing are examples of activities that are not included
within the term "production."
