HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 394, L.D. 498, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning the Administration of Laws by the Bureau
of Taxation."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

If bill sections 16, 17 and 18 of this bill are not
enacted, the result will be an approximately \$3.5 million yearly
decrease in state income tax revenues. Without these amendments,
the state is statutorily committed to following recent changes
in the federal treatment of low income allowances and standard
deductions.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add a necessary fiscal
note to the bill.
