COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 408, L.D. 502, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Facilitate Out-of-state Post Graduate Education in  
Certain Professions."

Amend the Bill by adding at the end before the Statement  
of Fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the  
General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural  
Services the sum of \$48,000 for the fiscal years ending June 30,  
1978, and June 30, 1979, to fund the cost of 4 places for Maine  
residents each year at the New England College of Optometry.
