STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning Special Agent Commissions for Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2401, sub-§ 3, 2nd ¶, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 516, § 12, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Such appointed clerk or other agent shall retain a fee of \$1 for each license issued.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to properly compensate the clerks and agents for their time and effort in selling and filing hunting and fishing licenses.
