AN ACT to Provide for Nonresident Taxpayer Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2401-B, sub-§ 3, ¶ F-1, is enacted to read:

F-1. Nonresident taxpayer season fishing \$15.50

Any nonresident 16 years of age or older who owns a dwelling in this State and who has paid property taxes on that dwelling within the last calendar year to either a municipality or to the State. This license category shall also apply to the spouse and to any dependent child of that nonresident.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that a nonresident property owner who owns a dwelling in Maine and who has paid property taxes on that dwelling within the last calendar year may purchase a season fishing license for \$15.50. This license category also applies to the spouse or to any dependent child of that nonresident taxpayer.
