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**AN ACT Relating to Overtaking or Passing School Buses.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 2019, sub-§ 6, is enacted to read:

6. Failure of school bus driver to comply with this section, misdemeanor. The operator of a school bus who fails to comply with this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction thereof, his permission to operate any school bus shall be revoked by the Secretary of State for a period of not less than 2 years.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the penalty for passing a stopped school bus by another school bus.
