Amend the Amendment in the 8th line by striking
out the underlined word "alternate" and inserting in
its place the underlined figure and abbreviation
'3rd'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require a vision
examination every 12 years beginning when a person
renews his license after reaching his 40th birthday.
The amendment reduces the appropriation by approximately
\$18,000 each subsequent year.
