STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Consumer Education by the Bureau of Consumer Protection.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

9-A MRSA § 6-203, sub-§ 4-A is enacted to read:

4-A. The bureau may charge fees to persons or organizations wishing to purchase educational materials produced and distributed by the bureau.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The DownEaster's Pocket Credit Guide is provided free of charge to Maine residents by the Bureau of Consumer Protection. The bureau charges 50c to nonresidents who wish to purchase the DownEaster.

The bureau expects substantial sales to nonresidents as a result of nationwide press coverage beginning February 10th. This amendment will insure that the bureau will be able to retain the profits from these sales and that the funds will be available to support the bureau's consumer education program.
