HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 418, L.D. 530, Bill, "AN ACT to  
Create a Board of Registration of Substance Abuse Counselors."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and in-  
serting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1.

/10 MRSA §8001, 2nd sentence, as last repealed and replaced

by PL 1977, c. 78, §36, is amended to read:

The department shall be composed of the following bureaus, boards  
and commissions:

Board of Examiners on Speech Pathology and Audiology;

Bureau of Banking;

Bureau of Consumer Protection;

Bureau of Insurance;

Electricians' Examining Board;

Oil Burner Men's Licensing Board;

Maine State Boxing Commission;

Real Estate Commission;

State Board of Examiners of Psychologists;

State Claims Board; and

State Running Horse Racing Commission; and

Board of Registration of Substance Abuse Counselors.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct the wording of the original bill as it concerns the placement of certain phrases in Title 10, section 8001. It does not affect the substance of the bill.
