COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 428, L.D. 536, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Meals Provided for Employees of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections."

Amend the bill in the 2nd line of the amending clause (same in L.D.) by striking out the words "a new sentence" and inserting the following figure and words '2 new sentences'

Further amend the bill by inserting in the last line after the following underlined word and punctuation, employment. and before the statement of fact (same in L.D.) the following underlined sentence:

'If such approval is given, the Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections shall establish standards which shall be applied uniformly at all institutions within the department.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require that the provision of meals for employees shall be made uniformly at all institutions of the department.
