STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Examination of Motor Vehicles by Law Enforcement Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 2121, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 731, §§ 57 and 58, is further amended by inserting after the 3rd sentence the following new sentence:

It shall be unlawful for any law enforcement officer to order the owner or occupant of a motor vehicle out of that vehicle pursuant to this section unless such person has been placed under arrest or the officer reasonably suspects that he, himself, is in danger of life or limb.
