HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 441, L.D. 548, Bill, "AN ACT to Reduce the Size of the Board of Directors of the Criminal Justice Planning and Assistance Agency and to Change the Appointment of the Executive Director."

Amend the Amendment by inserting before the 2nd paragraph before the Statement of Fact the following:

' Further amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§3354." by inserting at the end after the punctuation the following: When the board approves such grants to departments and agencies of State Government, the executive director shall forward a copy of approved grant application to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs through the Legislative Finance Office. Such information will include expected length of funding of such programs and restrictions or limitations placed on the grant application.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to have the Criminal Justice and Planning Assistance Agency inform the Legislature when they approve grants to departments and agencies.
