COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 452, L.D. 557, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require Direct Mailing and Verification of Absentee
Ballots and Concerning the Marking of Absentee Ballots."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 3 to 6
to be sections 2 to 5.

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes a requirement that the registrar
compare and verify signatures on absentee ballot applications
and registration cards.
