HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 454,
L.D. 559, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Instruction Posting under
the Election Laws."

Amend the Amendment by striking out the 2nd paragraph and
inserting the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out all
of the last underlined sentence and inserting in its place the
following:

'An instruction poster pursuant to section 572 shall be securely
placed above the shelf for the purpose of aiding the voter.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this Amendment is to delete the requirement
that instruction posters must be placed at eye level. The eye
level of a person 7 feet tall differs considerably from that of
a person 5 feet tall.
