HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 454, L.D. 559, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Instruction Posting under the Election
Laws."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out
all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in its
place the following:

'An instruction poster pursuant to section 572 shall be
securely placed at eye level above the shelf for the
purpose of aiding the voter.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 3 and
4 to be sections 2 and 3.

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the requirement in the bill
that posters be printed in the French language for use in
French-speaking communities.
