AN ACT Concerning the Veterans Preference in State Hiring.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 674, sub-§ 2, 1st ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 459, § 3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

2. Examination preference. Preference points shall be added to the earned qualifying rating in examinations, providing a passing grade is attained, of veterans applying for positions in the state service in accordance with the following.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to reinstate the 5 point veterans preference under the State Personnel System so that it may be available more than once.
